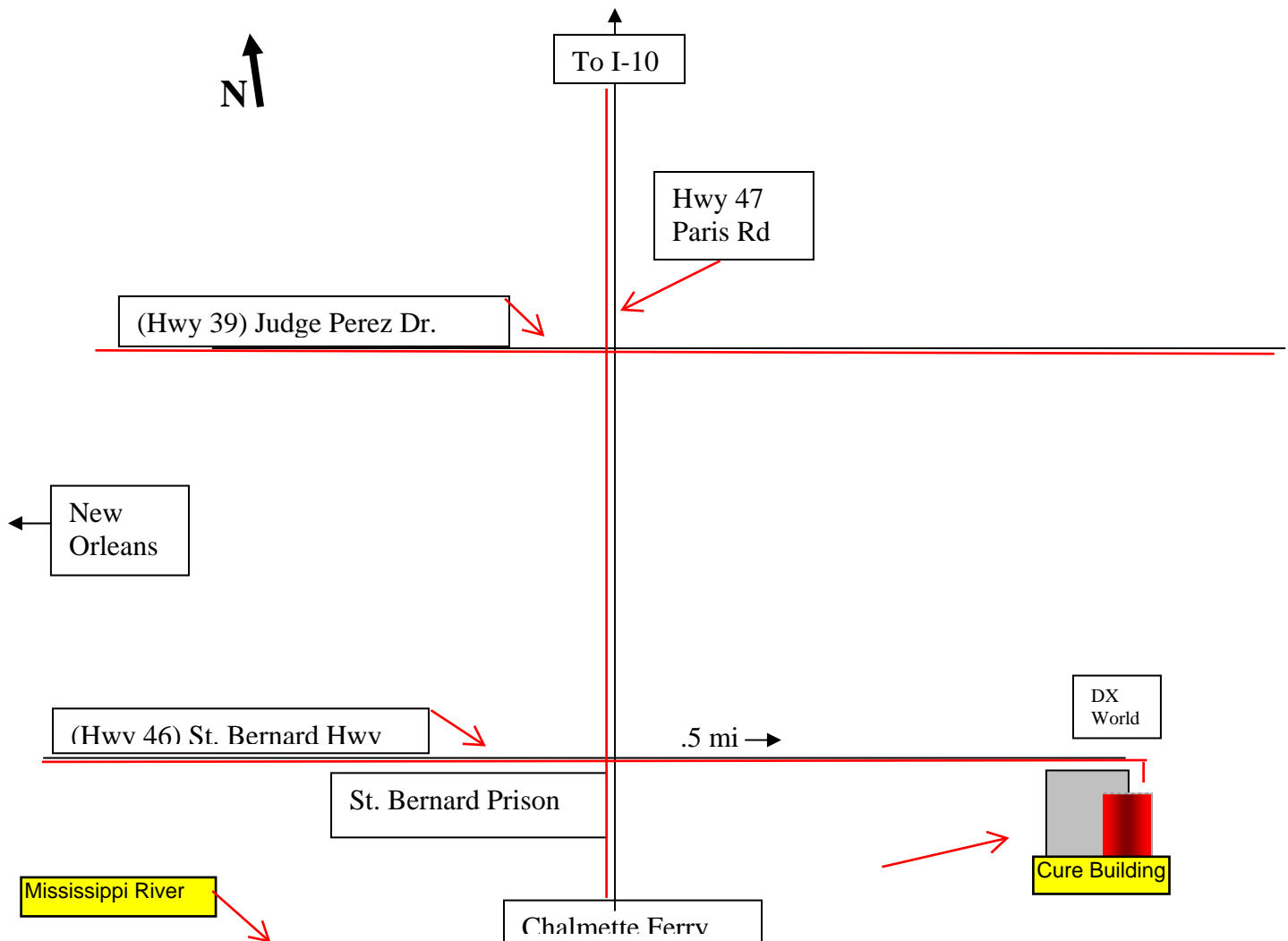

From I-10 take the Chalmette Exit south to Hwy 46 (St. Bernard Hwy) Just before the St. Bernard Parish Jail/Chalmette Refining, Turn Left (east) for ½ (.5) miles and the building will be a brownish brick building on your right. It is across the street from DX World.

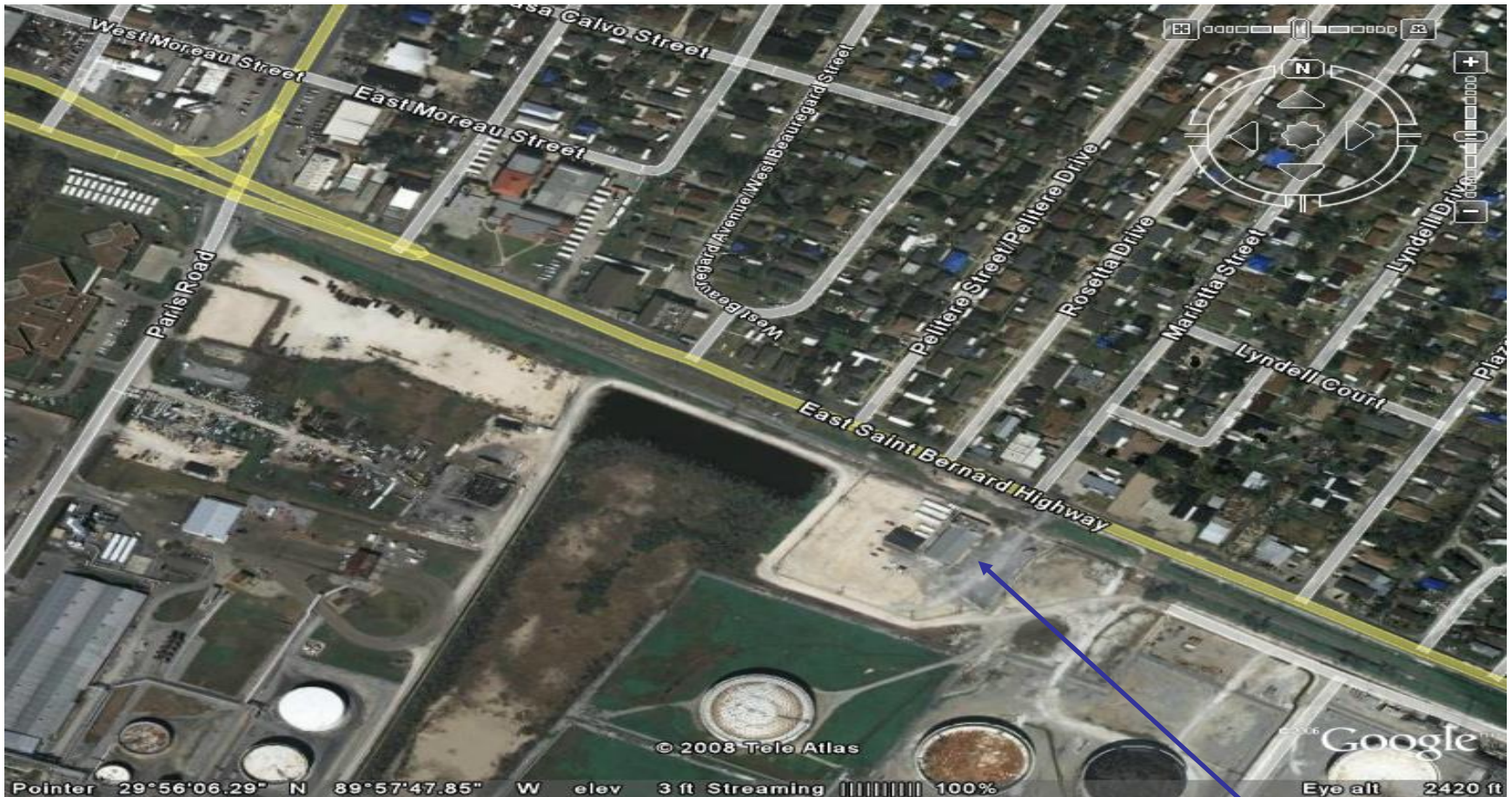
